Train/Pedestrian Accident Update

April 11, 2016 – The Buda Police Department has finished its part of the investigation into a deadly train/pedestrian accident. Investigators believe the death of 13-year-old Tanley Yacos was accidental. An official cause of death will not be listed until after the inquest is complete. Toxicology results are pending. No further information will be released at this time.

Yacos was killed in the early morning hours of March 26, 2016. At approximately 1:50 a.m. police responded to a call from a Union Pacific engineer at the railroad tracks between the South Loop 4 and Houston Street railroad crossings. Yacos was hit as she walked southbound near the tracks. She was pronounced dead at the scene.
