



Fireworks Prohibited in **City of Buda**

Buda, TX — The City of Buda is gearing up for the **Red, White, & Buda** July 4th Celebration at Buda City Park. Come celebrate with us and watch a spectacular fireworks show!

With Independence Day festivities around the corner, the City of Buda wanted to remind citizens that fireworks are prohibited in and around Buda. Fireworks cannot be used/detonated in the city limits or 5,000 feet into the ETJ (Extraterritorial Jurisdiction) unless you have a public display permit. Fireworks cannot be sold in the city limits, but can be sold in the ETJ.

Violation of the fireworks ordinance carries a fine not to exceed \$500, with each occurrence being a separate violation.

“The City has made a tremendous effort to educate the public regarding our ordinances that prohibit the use of fireworks inside the city limits as well as 5,000 feet into the ETJ surrounding the City,” Police Chief Bo Kidd said. “We will be fully staffed on Fourth of July weekend to enforce the no-fireworks ordinance.”
