The Municipal Facility and Public Safety Building are part of a \$55 million dollar bond approved by voters in November of 2014.

Proposition 1 – Municipal Facility - \$21 million

- Designed with many sustainable features
- Designed to connect with the local environment
- Designed with an emphasis on future modularity

City Hall/Library square footage is 53,000 sq. ft.

- 16,000 for library
- 18,400 for commons (including classrooms, multipurpose areas, and Council chambers)
- 18,700 for City Hall

Proposition 2 – Public Safety Facility - \$6.75 million

Public Safety building is 15,900 sq. ft.
