Town Halls and Neighborhood Pop-Up Sessions Are Designed to Educate Residents about Buda Bonds 2021

BUDA, TEXAS – The City of Buda is providing a series of “town hall” meetings and neighborhood “pop-up” sessions to help educate Buda residents about the general obligation bond package coming up on the **Nov. 2, 2021** ballot in Buda. The bond propositions primarily include transportation and parks projects totaling \$89.66 million.

To ensure Buda residents have the information they need to make informed decisions before voting, Buda residents are encouraged to attend one or more of the scheduled **free** events. Educational information will be made available at these events, and residents may ask questions about the projects entailed in each proposition.
